1. Policy

- 1.1 It is the policy of Correctional Services that supervision goals can be achieved through a wide range of modes of intervention. Some individuals may only require limited contact for monitoring in order to ensure compliance with court mandated conditions.
- 1.2 Community Corrections will establish and implement a modified counter reporting option which provides limited monitoring of select individuals to ensure ongoing compliance with court ordered conditions.

2. Modified (Counter) Reporting Option

- 2.1 Modified (counter) reporting may be utilized as a
 - 2.1.1 mode of intervention, in accordance with Policy and Procedures, Subject No. 14.03.00, <u>Supervision Standards Intervention Modes</u>
 - 2.1.2 operational contingency plan to address individual supervision issues during the absence of a probation officer (PO)

3. Procedures

- 3.1 Designation of an individual for modified counter reporting will be authorized by the PO or the SPO.
- 3.2 Where modified counter reporting is utilized, the PO or SPO will
 - 3.2.1 explain and have the individual sign the Modified Counter Reporting Agreement (see form 14.08.00 A)
 - 3.2.2 provide them with a copy
 - 3.2.3 a signed copy will be uploaded to JEIN
- 3.3 Where modified counter reporting is used as a supplemental mode of intervention or as an operational contingency plan, each time the individual reports, the PO will
 - 3.3.1 have the individual complete the Modified Counter Reporting Information form, (see form 14.08.00 B)
 - 3.3.2 enter an activity note and upload the form to the JEIN OCM
 - 3.3.3 provide the individual with a new reporting date

- 3.4 Whether modified counter reporting is applied as a supplemental mode of intervention or as a supervision option, the frequency of reporting will be consistent with established supervision levels and standards in accordance with Policy and Procedures, Subject No. 14.03.00, Supervision Standards Intervention Modes.
- 3.5 The SPO will review all modified counter reporting cases within the office on an ongoing basis and will be responsible for ensuring that the option is utilized properly.
- 3.6 Supervision may be reactivated at any time by the PO or SPO or at the request of the offender.

4. Exclusions

- 4.1 POs will determine an individual's eligibility for modified counter reporting by risk to reoffend in accordance with Policy and Procedures, Subject No. 28.01.00, <u>Youth Level of Service/Case Management Inventory</u>, <u>Level of Service/Case Management Inventory</u>.
- 4.2 Individuals excluded from consideration for modified counter reporting include
 - 4.2.1 medium risk individuals who have not completed
 - 4.2.1.1 the conditions of their Probation Order
 - 4.2.1.2 the agreed upon terms of their case plan
 - 4.2.2 maximum or above risk individuals
