**And whereas** the average of the average of the daily high and low reported product prices (in Canadian cents) for the period ended July 10, 2019, are:

**Now therefore** the Board prescribes the benchmark prices for petroleum products to be:

Ultra-low-sulfur diesel oil:	plus 0.25¢ per litre

**And now therefore** the Board prescribes the prices for petroleum products as set forth in Schedule “A” effective on and after 12:01 a.m., July 12, 2019.
