

Free Training Opportunity: Community Counts for Crime Prevention and Reduction

Community Counts for Crime Prevention and Reduction – a new crime prevention tool to aid communities in understanding crime (or lack of crime) in their local areas – has been developed jointly by the Nova Scotia Departments of Justice and Finance, with funding from the National Crime Prevention Centre. This tool can help communities paint a portrait of their local area and can be used to plan programs as well as provide benchmark statistics against which progress can be measured.

Community Counts for Crime Prevention and Reduction training sessions are being offered throughout the province. During the training session you will be provided training in the navigation and use of the system, an overview of data, and new features on the site which focus on crime prevention. This hands-on training, with each participant having their own computer to work on, will aid in your ability to use this tool in work-related projects.

Community Counts for Crime Prevention and Reduction training will be beneficial to those involved in, but not limited to, program development and delivery, policy development, research, municipal planning, community development projects, and strategic planning.
