**Schedule "A"**

**Regulations Respecting Distributor Licence Fees  
made by the Natural Products Marketing Council  
under Section 9 of Chapter 24 of the Acts of 2000,  
the *Dairy Industry Act***

**Citation**

- 1 These regulations may be cited as the *Distributor Licence Fees Regulations*.

**Definition of "net milk receipts"**

- 2 In these regulations, "net milk receipts" means receipts from producers net of any transfers of raw milk and bulk unpackaged cream to or from other provinces or processors, including the amount deducted for dipstick-to-meter shrinkage.

**Distributor licence fees**

- 3 A distributor of fluid dairy products to whom a licence has been issued must pay a fee of \$0.25 per hundred kilograms of butterfat to Council for Council services based on the total number of kilograms of butterfat that make up the net milk receipts during each calendar month, to be paid no later than 25 days after the end of that calendar month.
