(Note: Send certified cheque or money order...do not send cash in the mail.)
- B) Application deadline for the upcoming season is August 1st. Applications received between August 1st. and December 31st will be processed during the next calendar year.
- C) When a course date and location has been set you will be notified in time to attend that course.
- D) To successfully pass the course, each student must complete the following:
- attend all class sessions
 - pass a written exam (exams may be completed orally upon request)
 - shooting test (students are required to shoot 3 of 5 arrows into a 12-inch circle at various distances between 10 and 20 yards as selected by the instructor)
- (note: students must provide safe archery equipment for the shooting test including five arrows with field points only).

Neither the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) nor the Bowhunter Instructors Association of Nova Scotia (BIANS) will be liable in the event of injury sustained while attending the course. The DNR makes it mandatory for all first time bowhunters in Nova Scotia to successfully complete an approved Bowhunter Education course before they issue a certificate to carry a bow in wildlife habitat.
