

What is the Crown Land Information Management Centre (CLIMC)?

The CLIMC is the repository for all documents pertaining to Crown land in Nova Scotia. The purpose of the Crown Land Information Management Centre is to store, record and preserve all land-related documents involving Crown land.

What is Crown Land?

Crown lands are all or any part of the land under the administration and control of the Minister of Natural Resources. Of the 5.3 million hectares of land in Nova Scotia, about 1.25 million hectares (3.1 million acres or about 24% of the province) is designated as Crown land.

How can I request information?

The CLIMC provides information related to parcels of Crown land administered by the Department of Natural Resources (DNR). Please note the following resources regarding information about land other than Crown:

- Other land uses and/or designations (e.g. Federal Crown land, Game Sanctuaries, Wilderness Areas, Mineral claims, etc.)
