## Registration of Undertaking for Environmental Assessment ENVIRONMENT ACT

On April 8, 2010, General Liquids Canada Limited of 1233 Rocky Lake Drive, Waverley, Nova Scotia, B2R 1S1 registered an Asphalt Storage Terminal for environmental assessment in accordance with Part IV of the Environment Act.

The purpose of the proposed undertaking is to provide additional storage capacity of liquid asphalt cement for road construction contractors.
