Registration of Undertaking for Environmental Assessment ENVIRONMENT ACT

This is to advise that on July 11, 2007, M.S.D. Enterprises Limited registered the Glenholme Gravel Pit Expansion Development for environmental assessment, in accordance with Part IV of the *Environment Act*.

The purpose of the proposed Glenholme Gravel Pit Expansion Development (Project) is to supply aggregates, concrete, and manufactured soil. These products will be sold to various local markets including residential and commercial construction, municipal infrastructure, and road building projects. The Project consists of two existing gravel pit operations and expansion developments (North and South Properties) located near the community of Glenholme, Colchester County, NS, north and south of Trunk 2.

The total areas of development including existing and expanded operations are 10.2 ha for the North Property and 20.8 ha for the South Property. The anticipated combined average production rate is 155,000 tonnes per year. The scope of the future activities is similar to current and past activities and will encompass pit extraction, crushing, washing, stockpiling, and dry batch concrete production.
