Registration of Undertaking for Environmental Assessment ENVIRONMENT ACT

This is to advise that on March 23, 2022, Atlantic Mining NS Inc. (AMNS) registered an Addendum to the original Touquoy Gold Project Site Modifications Environmental Assessment Registration Document, in accordance with Part IV of the Environment Act, and in response to a request for additional information from Nova Scotia Environment and Climate Change dated September 8, 2021. The Addendum provides information regarding in pit tailings disposal, ground and surface water, wildlife, wetlands, the ship harbour long lake wilderness area, historic tailing and fish and fish habitat.

The purpose of the proposed undertaking is to support the existing operations at the Touquoy Gold Mine located in Moose River, Nova Scotia, 63 km northeast of Halifax and 19 km southeast of Middle Musquodoboit. The proposed modifications include use of the exhausted open pit for tailings deposition, expansion of the waste rock storage area and clay borrow area; and the realignment of the plant access road used to access the mill facility and administrative buildings. The approved development area of the mine site is approximately 271 ha; the proposed modifications will add approximately an additional 18 ha.
