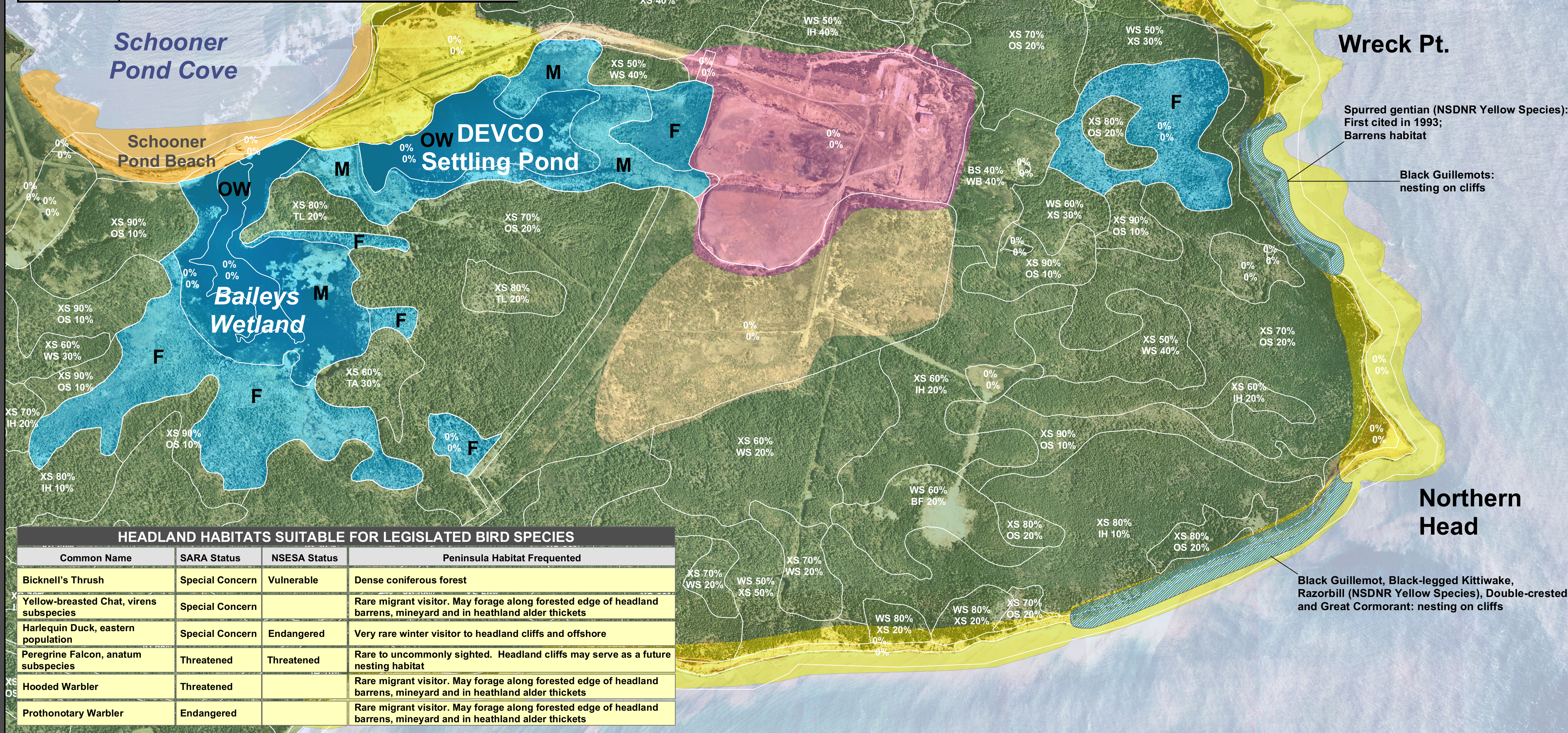

Bicknell's Thrush	Special Concern	Vulnerable	Dense coniferous forest
Yellow-breasted Chat, virens subspecies	Special Concern		Rare migrant visitor. May forage along forested edge of headland barrens, mineyard and in heathland alder thickets
Harlequin Duck, eastern population	Special Concern	Endangered	Very rare winter visitor to headland cliffs and offshore
Peregrine Falcon, anatum subspecies	Threatened	Threatened	Rare to uncommonly sighted. Headland cliffs may serve as a future nesting habitat
Hooded Warbler	Threatened		Rare migrant visitor. May forage along forested edge of headland barrens, mineyard and in heathland alder thickets
Prothonotary Warbler	Endangered		Rare migrant visitor. May forage along forested edge of headland barrens, mineyard and in heathland alder thickets
