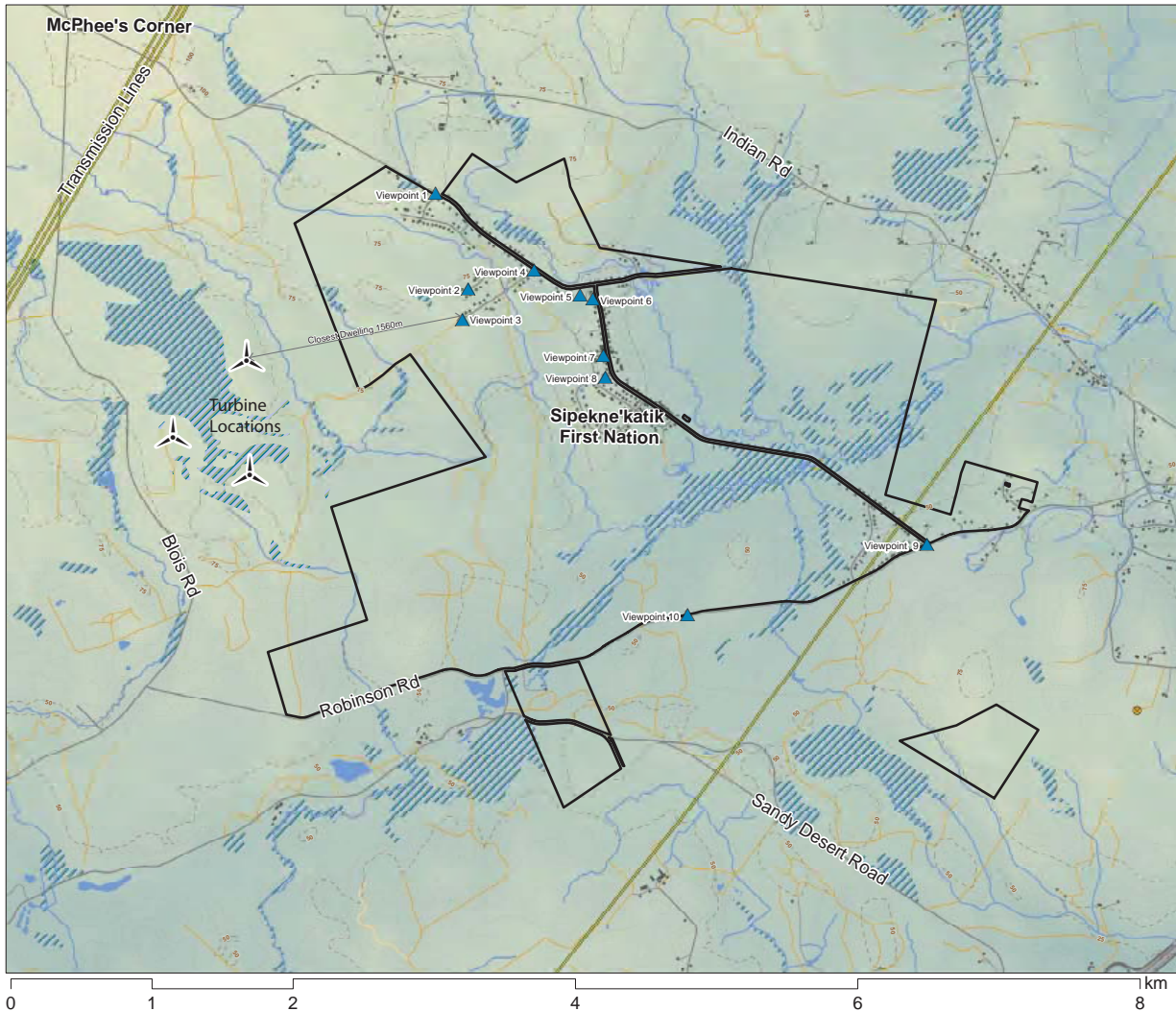

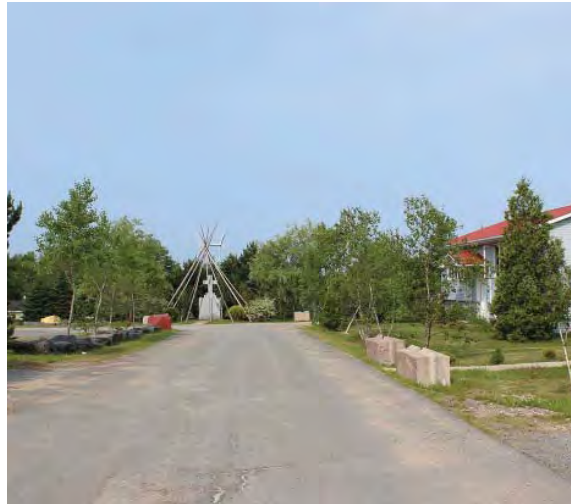

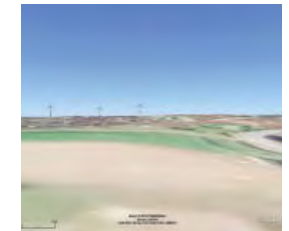

# Sound

All turbines produce a "woosh" sound as the blades pass in front of the tower. Operating turbines will also produce humming noise when the yaw motor steers the turbine into the wind. The distance the sound will travel depends on the wind, the forest cover, the topography and the weather.



Health Canada, in collaboration with Statistics Canada launched a multi-year research study in July 2012 to explore the relationship between exposure to sound levels produced from wind turbines and the extent of health effects reported by, and objectively measured in, those living near wind turbines.

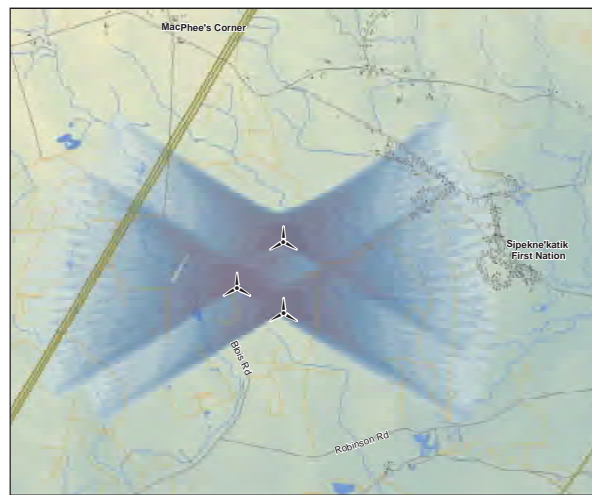
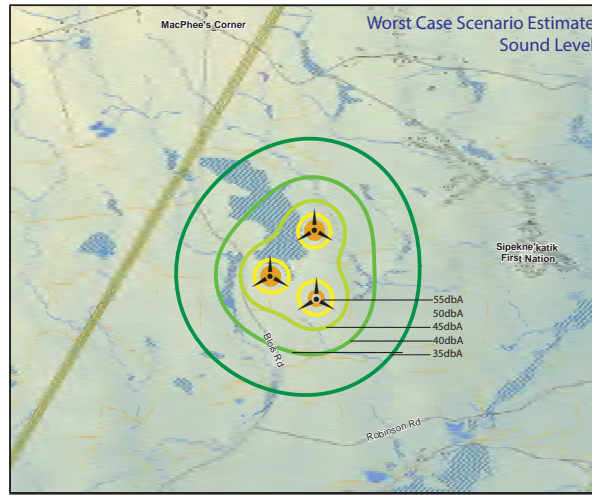
In 2014 they published the study and found **No link** between wind turbine noise and illness and chronic disease, stress, or sleep.

# Shadow Flicker

Shadow flicker occurs when the sun shines through the rotating blades of a turbine. For shadow flicker to occur, the sun must be shining and the turbine must be spinning. Shadows vary with the time of day, the time of year, the orientation of the turbine in relation to the sun and the weather.

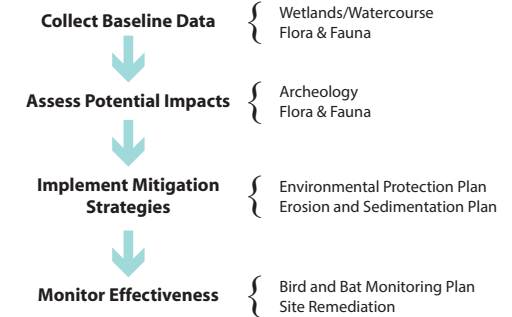
The graphic to the right shows an estimate of the worst case shadow zone. The farthest reaches of the shadow flicker occurs on the winter solstice (approx Dec. 21) which is the day when the sun is lowest and shadows are longest. This model assumes the sun is always shining, the turbine is always spinning and it does not take trees, cloudiness or wind direction into account.

The provincial standard requires that no home should receive shadow for more than 30 hours/year and no more than 5 hours at a time.



# Environment

An Environmental Assessment (EA) is a formal process overseen and reviewed by the Nova Scotia Department of Environment. The purpose is to assess, mitigate and monitor the impacts of a project. The Environmental Assessment for this project is ongoing and will be registered this summer. Third party consultants are undertaking a process that looks like this:

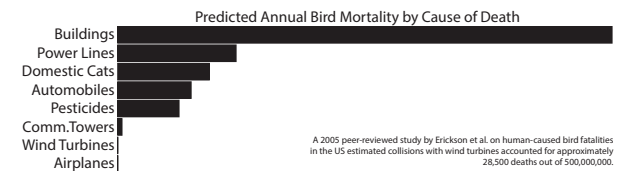


The project is not expected to have major impacts to plant or land-based wildlife. Some bird and bat mortalities are expected, however they are not expected to be significant. A post construction bird and bat monitoring plan will be implemented.

Canada Warbler, a 'species of conservational interest' has been identified in the area. Special surveys before and after construction are being conducted to ensure that any impacts are minimized.

# Impacts in Context

Any time people alter the natural world, there are going to be impacts. With site-specific environmental studies and the conscientious placement of roads and turbines, we minimize our adverse impacts. For example, Wind turbines are known to be a cause of bird and bat kills, but to a lesser degree than other human activities.



A 2005 peer-reviewed study by Erickson et al. on human-caused bird fatalities in the US estimated collisions with wind turbines accounted for approximately 28,500 deaths out of 500,000,000.

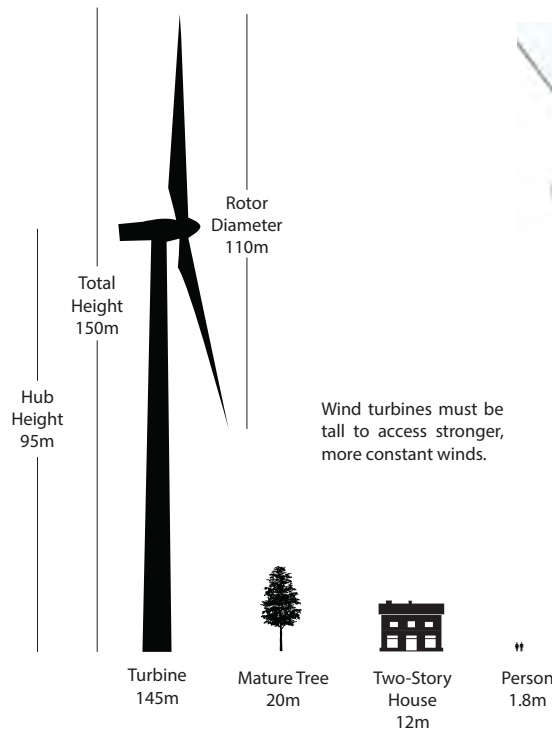

### About the Project

Scotian Wind has proposed to install a wind energy project consisting of three wind turbine generators near Blois Road in the Hardwood Lands/Shubenacadie area. The capacity of the project will be 6 MW, representing enough energy to power approximately 1,700 Nova Scotia homes per year. The tower for these turbines are projected to be 95 meters high. Each rotor blade measures about 55 meters in length, placing the total height of the each turbine at 150m.

The project has been awarded conditional approval from the Department of Energy as a Community Feed-In-Tariff project. Scotian Wind Inc. is in the process of studying the wind energy potential and conducting environmental studies. This research will be conducted over the next year with a targeted plan begin construction in order to facilitate installation of the project in mid-2016

### About the Community Feed-In-Tariff Program

The Community Feed-In-Tariff or COMFIT is a program of the Government of Nova Scotia that is designed to encourage the wide distribution of renewable energy projects throughout the province and promote the technical know-how to help communities get those projects off the ground. COMFIT projects are small in scale because they are limited to the local distribution grid and they are restricted to "community-based participants" in order that the benefits of investment remain in the community.

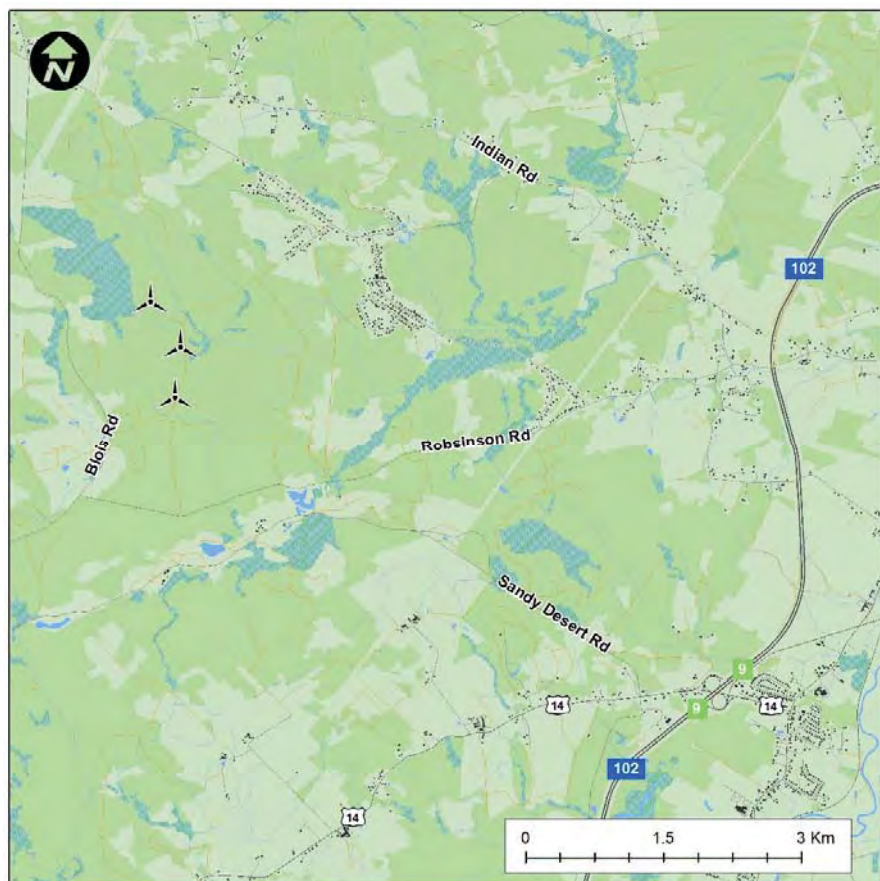

Thank you for inviting Scotian Wind to speak to council about our Hardwood Lands Proposal on February 5<sup>th</sup>, 2015.

As outlined at the meeting, in our current site plan, two of our turbines would be located 320 metres and 400 metres respectively from the property line of the Band. Under Municipality of East Hants Bylaw, we require a Non-Turbine Land Agreement (NTLA) with any land owner within 600m from a turbine. Therefore, we have approached Band Council to discuss options to draft an agreement that will benefit the Band and enable Scotian Wind to locate the turbines in the proposed location. The NTLA does not allow any access or infrastructure whatsoever on Band lands.

In exchange for signing the NTLA, we are offering to perform a Renewable Energy feasibility study that can set the Band up to build and own their own renewable energy infrastructure.

As a result of this study and the permit administration that we would oversee, the Band would be able to proceed to site and install a turbine(s) under their ownership that will be capable of offsetting a significant portion of their current energy cost. We have included an attachment that outlines the features and benefits of this arrangement.

A tour of one of our turbine installation sites may help in the decision-making and help Band Council visualize the turbines. We propose to take Council on a tour of the Martock Ridge Community Wind Project, located within the Town of Windsor's municipal source watershed if they so desire.

We welcome the opportunity to meet again soon to explore the opportunity to develop the renewable resources of the Band and to conclude the NTLA and the cooperative development agreement.

## Background

Scotian experienced in assessing and developing renewable energy project. With more than 40MW contracted under the Community Feed-In-Tariff program of the Nova Scotia government, including 8 successful utility grade projects installed in the past 3 years, Scotian has a proud history in working with community based projects. Scotian also has extensive experience in smaller renewable energy projects, having installed dozens of net metering projects in Nova Scotia.

Scotian is presently proposing a three turbine facility in lands adjacent to Sipekne'katik. As a part of this process Scotian is requesting that a Non-Turbine Land Agreement be executed with Sipekne'katik. This is essentially stating that Sipekne'katik supports the project but there are absolutely no land rights for Scotian associated with this agreement. In exchange, Scotian is offering to assist Sipekne'katik with energy issues on the reserve and provide the support needed to establish a renewable power production facility for the sole benefit of Sipekne'katik.

## Proposal Overview:

In recognition of Sipekne'katik's support for the project, Scotian is offering to assist Sipekne'katik in creating a strategic energy plan and navigating the process of developing their own wind project. This is a significant and detailed undertaking that ultimately will identify the best possible project and also provide the detail required to move the project into reality.

For overall energy use and efficiency, Scotian is offering to:

- In collaboration with Sipekne'katik, conduct band level review of energy consumption and assess potential strategies for power production and conservation,
- Identify potential renewable projects for wind, solar photovoltaic and solar thermal technologies,
- Identify potential conservation strategies

For a potential wind power project, Scotian is offering to:

- In collaboration with Sipekne'katik, develop a preliminary project schedule,
- Assess the wind resource in the area,
  - Use Scotian proprietary wind data from local meteorological tower,
  - In collaboration with Sipekne'katik, determine optimal location for a wind turbine(s),
  - Conducted detailed Wind Resource Assessment of the chosen site(s)
- On behalf of Sipekne'katik, work with Nova Scotia Power on preliminary connection assessments, including application fees,
  - Identify regional permitting processes,
- Complete of any permits required, such as:
  - Department of National Defense,
  - NAVCAN,
  - Transport Canada,
  - Environment Canada,
  - Coast Guard / DFO,



- Provide assistance for interconnections activities ,
- Provide assistance for turbine procurement,
- Develop preliminary project Budget and financial proforma based on:
  - Procurement costs,
  - Construction costs,
  - Maintenance costs,
  - Wind Analysis.
- Develop a finance ready project package that encompasses all of the above elements.

### **Accessing the Market**

Enhanced Net-Metering is the current and best access to the electricity market for self-generators in Nova Scotia. Enhanced net-metering allows any Nova Scotia Power account holder to offset their power consumption with renewable electricity generation. Electricity is purchased as usual when the generator is not producing, and excess electricity is sold back to the grid at the same rate. Enhanced net-metering is limited to:

- A total generator capacity roughly equal to one account holder's annual consumption.
  - Power consumption is measured by previous years; therefore any reduction in consumption after the installation of the turbines will only increase savings
- A generator no larger than 1000 KW
- A generator must be in the same distribution zone (same substation) as the consumption.
- Customers are allowed more than one generator through separate applications.

Sipekne'katik energy usage is in an approximate range of 8,000 MWhr per year, which is ample opportunity to take advantage of the program. The greatest impediment to wind development is the pricing of electricity per kilowatt hour. As energy prices currently are in the \$0.15/kWh range in NS, enhanced net metering is one of, if not the most lucrative programs in the country for wind power. The program is limited to 1,000kW generators but there is likely a strategy that Sipekne'katik could utilize to fully take advantage of the program and high energy costs by installing two turbines which would have to be configured as independent units.

According to our discussions, the band pays approximately 1.2 million a year for energy costs; two turbines could offset a significant portion of that cost. To determine the amount of energy that could be saved by this project, Scotian will create a preliminary financial proforma. The wind regime of a site, the properties of a particular turbine and cost of purchasing, installing and maintaining a turbine, all determine the projected budget.

This is a unique opportunity for Sipekne'katik to become a leader in energy independence by using the resources and expertise of an established developer at no additional cost.



## Case Study: Wind Project in a Watershed

The Martock Ridge Community Wind Project is a 3 turbine, 6 MW wind farm located near Three Mile Plains that was completed in January 2015. It is comparable in scope to the proposed Hardwood Lands Community Wind Project.

The turbines are located inside of the Mill Lakes Watershed, a large natural bowl on Martock Ridge. Water collects in the Mill lakes and drains to the north via fall brook. The Town of Windsor draws their municipal water from Fall Brook and has protected the entire watershed to ensure water quality. While the town owns the land where the turbines are situated, the project was subject to a development agreement with the Municipality of West Hants. Everyone in Windsor depends that water quality.

The project took shape with oversight of governmental bodies like the Municipality of West Hants and the Town of Windsor, and citizen groups, such as the Watershed Advisory Committee. The result was a design that included the turbine sites upstream of the water treatment plant where water quality is constantly tested.

The road was completed in the early fall of 2014 and components arrived on site in November. The roads are stabilized and the operating turbines will now produce enough power to offset about 15,000 tonnes of CO<sub>2</sub> a year.

## Construction Information

The turbine sites are each approximately 1 hectare in size to accommodate the crane pad and turbine components. The access road and turbine sites are made of compacted gravel to hold the heavy loads for delivery and construction.

The turbines themselves are anchored by steel and concrete foundations about 4 m deep that are back filled, leaving only a 4.5 m wide circle above ground. The steel tower base was bolted to the foundation and the rest of the pre-fabricated components were then lifted and secured in place. The gravel pads around the base of the turbine will be replanted with grass in the spring.

At no point during the construction was the quality of water compromised.

The largest risk to water quality is during road construction, when exposed earth can wash into nearby streams and wetlands. Under the close scrutiny several government agencies, Scotian took steps to ensure water quality such as:

- Drainage and erosion control were included in the road design,
- An Environmental Protection Plan was written and approved before construction,
- Scotian developed an Erosion and Sedimentation Control Plan that included:
  - A point person for Erosion and Sediment controls to review, upgrade, and maintain the control measures,
  - Soil stabilization and sediment controls, silt fences, berms, ponds, and check dams were installed at the same time that the road and crane pads were built,
  - No more than 1 hectare of land was exposed without erosion controls,
  - The quality of these measures were verified before and after a rainfall of more than 10mm;
- Diversion ditches installed to keep clean water clean,
- An Environmental Monitor was on site to ensure:
  - The Environmental Protection Plan was adhered to,
  - The safe use of fuels and lubricants associated with constructions sites,
  - Spill kits were on site in case of an accident.

The Municipality of East Hants Bylaw requires a Non-Turbine Land Agreement (NTLA) with any landowner within 600 meters of a turbine.

Sipekne'katik is not prepared to sign the NTLA. The proposed turbine site location restricts Sipekne'katik in future residential expansion, future development and current use of this area. As such, this project may have an adverse impact on Mi'kmaq rights and title.

This letter is to follow-up with you about our previous correspondence regarding our Hardwood Lands wind energy project near the Sipekne'katik Band's land and our proposal to assist and support Sipekne'katik in your renewable energy development efforts. Since our previous discussions and as a result of feedback gained from Sipekne'katik, we have redesigned the Hardwood Lands project with turbines to the west, to ensure we exceed the Municipality of East Hants Bylaw requiring a separation distance between a non-participating lot and wind turbine of 4 times the height of the turbine, or 600 metres in this case.

Although we are no longer seeking a Non-Turbine Land Agreement (NTLA) with Sipekne'katik, we would like to continue to offer you our expertise and experience as you develop your own independent renewable energy systems.

We would like to further the dialogue regarding the renewable energy feasibility study proposed to Sipekne'katik in the letter from Scotian Wind dated February 20th, 2015, whereby we would provide a renewable energy feasibility study and infrastructure support. The opportunity for Sipekne'katik to achieve energy independence is a tangible benefit we can offer. The net metering program with Nova Scotia Power allows any account holder to offset their annual energy consumption by generating renewable energy. This could apply to individual homes, or the total combined consumption paid for by the Sipekne'katik band.

A combination of band-owned solar arrays and wind turbines will generate power that can be used by residents of the community, with the excess power being sold back to the grid through the net-metering program. Additionally, energy demand can be reduced by installing solar hot water systems that pre-heat water for institutional or domestic use.

This proposal presents an opportunity for individuals or the whole Sipekne'katik band to:

- Generate your own electricity and offset your power costs,
- Reduce your power consumption with more efficient technologies,
- Pay to own generating infrastructure, rather than just electric bills,
- Train technicians to install and maintain solar projects,
- Set a precedent of energy independence.



As well, in the spirit of open communication, we would like to propose that we hold an open house for the residents of Indian Brook and the band members of Sipekne'katik, so that they can better understand the nature of our Hardwood Lands project and discuss renewable energy. At that open house, community members can meet our staff and share their input about the Hardwood Lands project. Staff can listen to feedback and answer their questions and concerns. We would like to hold this open house in advance of the Environmental Assessment so that the grassroots input of Sipekne'katik is included in the environmental considerations. We will also be including a Mi'kmaq Ecological Knowledge Study as a key component of the environmental work. An initial open house with the people of the community will support that process as well.

Finally, we feel that a meeting with Council will be worthwhile for bringing Sipekne'katik up-to-date on the progress of our Hardwood Lands wind project, for discussion of the benefits of a renewable energy feasibility study, and to guide us in the planning of a community open house.

We will be in touch to discuss a meeting with council and the possibility of holding an open house as described above. Should you have any questions or comments, please do hesitate to contact us.

We would like to update you on our project planning for the Hardwood Lands Wind Project.

We have arranged to hold an open house at the St. Catherine's Church on July 14 from 6:30pm to 8pm. At the open house, we will share details of the project, information about wind energy in general, as well as impacts and benefits for the community. Our staff will be present to listen to feedback and answer questions and concerns. We hope you and council will be able to attend.

I think it would be worthwhile for us to meet in advance of the community open house, in order to share ideas about community benefits from our project. To be clear, we have relocated the project beyond the 600m setback from the parcel line and are no longer seeking a Non Turbine Land Agreement. However, we maintain in good faith the offers for community projects outlined in the letter sent May 22 and February 19, 2015:

- A feasibility study and for the development, procurement and installation of band-owned wind turbines and/or solar panels to offset power usage.
  - Training of band members to work with solar team to install and maintain panels
- Tour of nearby turbine site to demonstrate the intended project

Scotian is a community owned company that gives back to our neighbours. Our company policy is to establish a Community Liaison Committee (CLC) in each of our project communities and contribute a percentage of gross revenue to the community. The CLC is an open line of communication between Scotian and the community and also serves to distribute the funds.

This project is still in the development stage and the CLC has not yet been established, and Sipekne'katik is the closest community to the project. Given the CLC has yet to be established for our project, we would like to offer the Sipekne'katik Band an opportunity to act as part of our CLC. This would involve a percentage from the gross revenue that would equal 0.5 percent annually. Based on the size of this project, we would expect that amount to be on the order of approximately \$11,500 annually.

Lastly, we have a history of investing in public infrastructure in the communities near our projects. With this in mind, we would also like to speak with you about installing a solar system at our expense as a pilot project for band owned solar electricity generation. We believe that Sipekne'katik can benefit from Scotian Wind's expertise to build infrastructure and capacity for the band.

Thank you for your information request to augment your background study for the above noted project.

Based on the map you provided me for the above noted project, a brief review of our internal GIS database has yielded a vast number of traditional use locations ranging from food harvesting – both floral and faunal – ceremonial item collection, forest products, encampment sites, ceremonial plant collection, and perhaps the most concerning with respect to archaeological potential – spirit beings. It has been my experience that there is frequently a co-location of spirit beings and either archaeological or burial sites. The number of traditional use records for your study area appears to exceed 200 sites of a variety of types and no less than 5 separate locations of spirit beings. Some of these latter locations are in your study area, some are close to it. The intensity of traditional use sites in the area and the evidence for temporal depth suggest to me that your study area has very high archaeological potential and should, if selected for development, be subjected to intensive subsurface testing to ensure no resources undetectable through surface survey are impacted. Roughly 5 km from your study area, I have also noted 2 placenames, the first recorded for southwest of your study area by Ganong as Gisna Nenetogoepogoeg. No meaning for this placename was recorded. To the east, approximately 5 km away (but this may be an artefact of digitizing the data – so a shift could be expected), was recorded S. (Sainte) Antlegatig, by Pacifique. Based on my limited knowledge of Mi'kmaw, I think it could mean St. Andrew's Place or Andrew's Place – perhaps a revered spiritual leader, like a putus (spiritual expert) or a member of the Sante Mawiomi (Grand Council). The current Kji Keptin of the Grand Council is Antle (pronounced "Ahndalay")(aka Andrew) Denny. I have not gone through our Senior Research Officer's notes on her archival research, but expect that you have included a thorough search of the archives as a standard part of your background study. Further, we are still working to georeference her archival research notes and they presently have not been completed in GIS format to cover this study area. Given the proximity of your study area to Sipe'kene'katik First Nation, I trust your work has already highlighted an elevated concern for impacts to Mi'kmaw resources. Since Sipe'kene'katik is not a current member of the Made In Nova Scotia process that defines the mandate of my office (KMKNO) I recommend you also get in touch with Sipe'kene'katik. Perhaps the Mi'kma'ki All Points Services (MAPS) office may be able to help guide you.

The Assembly of Nova Scotia Mi'kmaq Chiefs, KMKNO and the Mi'kmaw Nation in Nova Scotia expects a high level of archaeological investigative diligence and cultural attention when archaeological research is conducted. To this end, we highlight the need for evidence-based decisions rooted in subsurface testing to demonstrate presence, absence, distribution and characterization of archaeological remnants from L'nu'k ancestors, particularly in the early phases of research such as reconnaissance and survey. Any archaeological excavation work beyond this phase should be conducted in accordance with a fieldwork and interpretation plan developed in partnership and consultation with the Mi'kmaq. Subsurface testing can help demonstrate the depositional histories of specific areas where archaeological and cultural heritage interests will or will not exist. In the absence of subsurface testing, there is an expectation of photo documentation of the lack of archaeological potential or concern to help us understand why no testing has taken place. Further, GPS track logs when disturbance / survey areas are in remote or undeveloped areas are expected to form a standard part of the final report to provide future researchers an understanding of where onsite research has been conducted, specifically. The importance of gathering samples for palaeoethnobotanical analysis is also a priority where archaeological investigations encounter suitable features (hearths, occupation floors, etc.). Finally, please note that while archaeological artefacts or cultural objects no longer in their primary archaeological contexts have compromised and perhaps little scientific value, they continue to have great cultural value. Therefore, testing and/or monitoring of areas that may have contained archaeological sites but were previously disturbed is still a priority for Mi'kmaq in respect of the principle of cultural value of any remaining objects and knowledge of the place where ancestors had been even if the place has been altered in the modern or historic periods.
