Registration of Undertaking for Environmental Assessment ENVIRONMENT ACT

This is to advise that on October 18, 2013 Scotian WindFields Inc., Scotian Wind Inc., and WEB Wind Energy North America Inc. registered the proposed Nine Mile River Community Wind Project for environmental assessment, in accordance with Part IV of the *Environment Act*.

The purpose of the proposed undertaking is to construct and operate a 4.0 MW Wind Project at a site in the community of Renfrew, approximately 13 km northwest of Enfield, Nova Scotia in the Municipality of the District of East Hants. Pending approval to proceed, construction is anticipated to commence Summer/Fall 2014 with operations to begin Fall/Winter 2014.
