## Registration of Undertaking for Environmental Assessment ENVIRONMENT ACT

This is to advise that on September 21, 2005 Clayton Developments Limited registered the proposed Russell Lake West Wetland Alteration for environmental assessment, in accordance with Part IV of the *Environment Act*.

The purpose of the proposed undertaking is to construct a berm across a wetland situated southeast of Highway 111 and north of Waynewood Drive and Brompton Road. A municipal trunk sewer and water main will be installed within the berm. Clayton is proposing to infill the northwest portion of the wetland and install an adjacent stormwater retention facility for stormwater control. The proposed undertaking will commence in early 2006.
