Registration of Undertaking for Environmental Assessment ENVIRONMENT ACT

This is to advise that on June 4, Provincial Energy Ventures LLC (PEV) registered the PEV Wharf Approach Deepening Project for environmental assessment, in accordance with Part IV of the provincial *Environment Act*. The project is also undergoing a federal screening-level environmental assessment under the *Canadian Environmental Assessment Act*.

The recent deepening of the access channel in Sydney Harbour, Cape Breton, Nova Scotia has facilitated commercialization of the Harbour. The purpose of the proposed undertaking is to deepen the approach to the Atlantic Canada Bulk Terminal (ACBT) wharf facility in the South Arm of Sydney Harbour so that PEV can use the facility for larger vessels than can presently be accommodated. Dredged sediment will be transferred to and disposed within a newly constructed Confined Disposal Facility (CDF) in Blast Furnace Cove that will eventually be reclaimed as an expanded laydown area for the PEV facility. CDF construction is proposed to commence in the summer of 2012. The dredging is planned to occur immediately after the CDF construction is complete (late summer) and take 1-2 months to complete.
