PLEASE NOTE:

You have purchased a pesticide for an "excepted use". According to the *Exceptions to Prohibitions on Non-Essential Pesticides Regulations*, excepted uses are when pests: 1) pose a risk to public health; 2) compromise structural integrity of buildings; or 3) threaten the economy or environment because of their invasive capability.

Examples of excepted uses include the control of insects, plants and fungi that may:

- be a health concern, such as European Fire Ant; or
- be poisonous to the touch, such as poison ivy; or
- be an invasive species, such as Japanese Knotweed; or
- cause structural damage to buildings, such as carpenter ants.

The use of this pesticide to control weeds, insects or fungi in, on or over your lawn, outdoor tree, shrub, flower or ornamental plant is prohibited.

It is important to read and understand the pesticide label.

You may wish to inform your neighbours prior to spraying this product.

You may also wish to consider using a product from the List of Allowable Pesticides, or control methods that do not rely on the use of pesticides.
