APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. You must provide documentation that indicates your exam results or attach PRCP re-certification credit forms if you are renewing.
2. The cost for one certificate is \$59.68. Certificates are valid for five years from date of issue. Please make cheque or money order payments payable to the Minister of Finance.
3. If you are applying for more than one certificate class, the cost is \$59.68 for your initial certificate. The cost of additional certificate classes is \$11.93 per certificate.
4. Expiry dates of any additional certificates coincide with the expiry date of the initial certificate.
5. Certificate Card Replacement: If you have lost your certificate card, replacement cards can be purchased for a fee of \$11.93.
6. Reciprocity is defined as the acceptance by Nova Scotia Environment (NSE) of a pesticide certificate approved by another provincial regulatory agency.

Requirements for Reciprocity: You must apply to NSE to obtain recognition of a pesticide certificate granted in another province. Reciprocity, if accepted, will be granted on the remaining years of a certificate, provided the applicant has written the appropriate exam within the past five years or the other province has a recertification program similar to NSE's. Certificate holders will be required to meet NSE's recertification requirements upon expiry of their certificate.

You must provide the following information: 1) a completed application form; 2) photocopy of certificate/license; 3) original or photocopy of a letter indicating the exam result and the classification written. Each application for reciprocity is reviewed on a case by case basis. If you do not qualify for reciprocity you must write the appropriate certification exam in Nova Scotia.

PLEASE NOTE:

Business Operators Certificate : If you are operating a commercial pesticide business or enter into contracts to handle, use, store, or sell commercial or restricted class pesticides you require a Class IX Business Operator's Certificate. The application fee for a Business Operator Certificate is \$29.70 per year.
