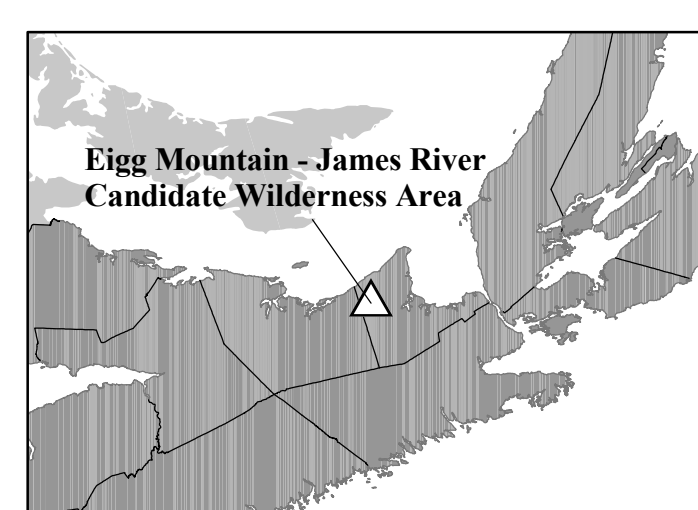


Eigg Mountain - James River Candidate Wilderness Area

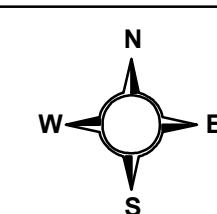

Ecosystem Types †

- Well-drained, tolerant hardwoods-dominated mixedwood, rolling terrain
- Well-drained, tolerant hardwoods, rounded hills
- Well-drained, tolerant hardwood-dominated mixedwood, canyon
- Well-drained, tolerant hardwoods-red spruce, undulating terrain
- Well-drained, tolerant hardwoods-dominated mixedwood, broad flat-topped hills
- Well-drained, tolerant hardwoods, steep side slope
- Well-drained, tolerant hardwood, hills
- Well to imperfectly drained, mixed forests, undulating terrain
- Imperfectly drained, coniferous-dominated, undulating terrain
