



Roseway River Addition

COUNTY: Shelburne

WILDERNESS AREA: Tobeatic

SIZE: 112.7 hectares (278.5 acres)

DESCRIPTION

- This addition consists of 5 properties which were acquired from a local landowner in 2010 for addition to Tobeatic Wilderness Area.
- Extensive wetlands and mature maple forest border more than 3 km of the Roseway River and Quinlan Creek. This area provides habitat for a large population of painted turtles.
- This part of the Roseway River system hosts a rare subtropical moss (*Isopterygium tenerum*) and another moss (*Sphagnum macrophyllum*) which is considered extremely rare in Nova Scotia.
- The area's waterways are popular for canoeing and trout fishing.
- Adding this addition to Tobeatic Wilderness Area will help protect the area's natural features and recreation opportunities, simplify boundaries and support effective management and enforcement.
