

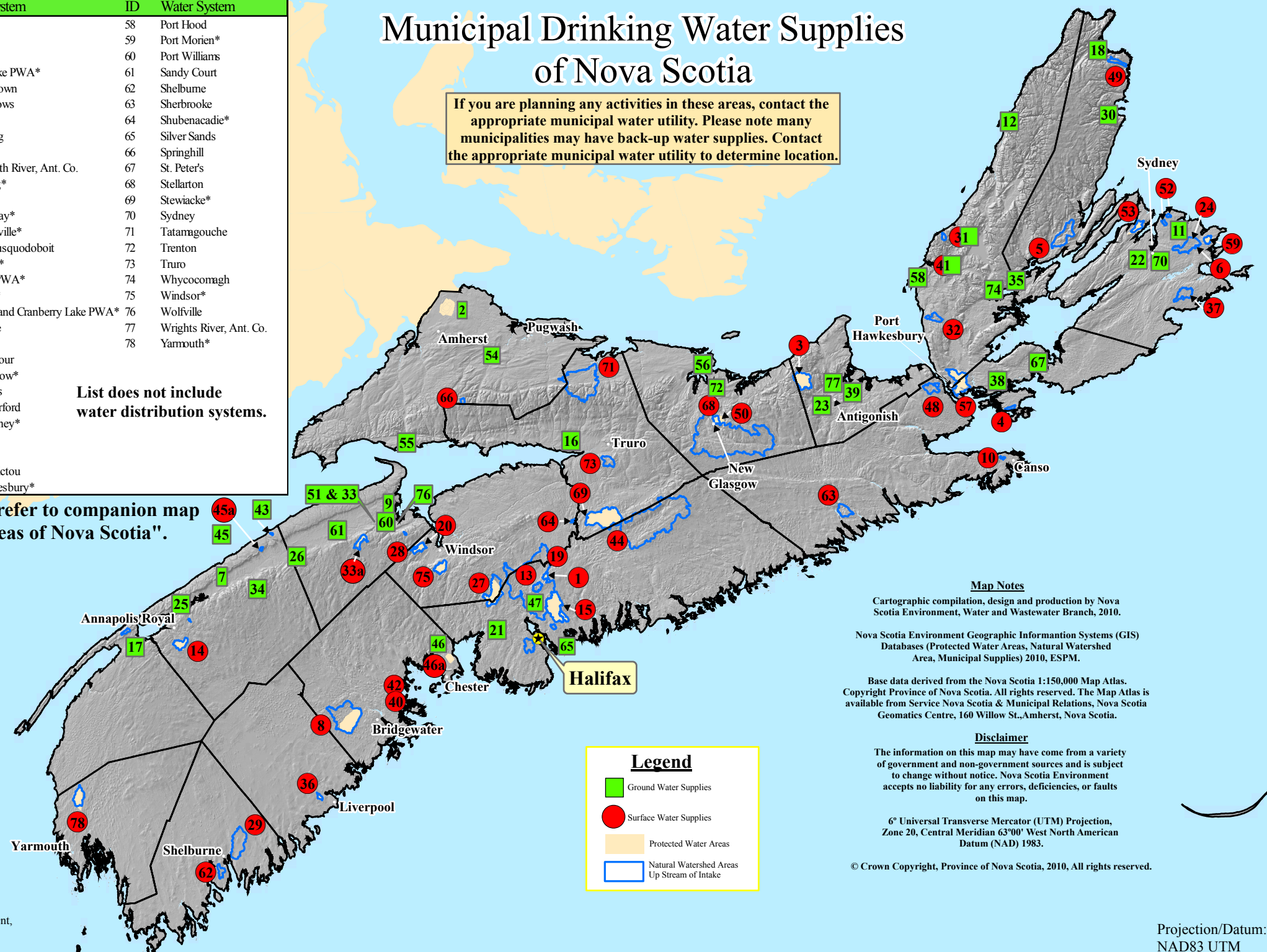
Municipal Drinking Water Supplies of Nova Scotia
