





only if the accused is in jail

Typically, these are the steps you would participate in.

The steps listed here may not alwavs occur in every case.

Election

depends on the seriousness of the charge

Preliminary inquiry

only if the case is held in Supreme Court and the accused has NOT waived their right to a preliminary inquiry

Trial

only if there is a realistic prospect of conviction

Verdict

only if there is a trial

Sentencing

only if the accused pleads quilty or is found quilty

Appeal

only if the Crown Attorney or defence lawyer decides to appeal the verdict or sentence
