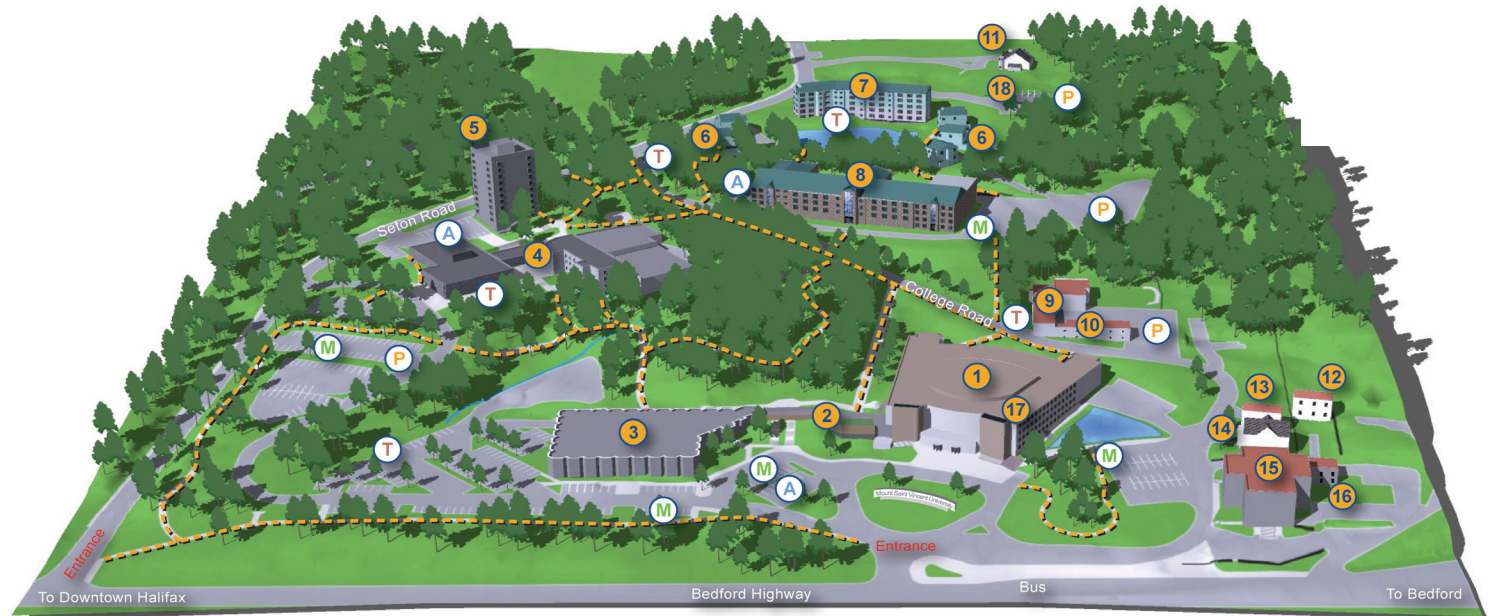


Campus Map
