



JOIN THE DIAL-A-RIDE NOVA SCOTIA NETWORK

WHAT IS DIAL-A-RIDE NOVA SCOTIA?

Dial-a-Ride Nova Scotia is the name the Province of Nova Scotia registered with the Nova Scotia Registry of Joint Stocks on November 3, 1999. The concept for Dial-a-Ride Nova Scotia arose out of the Inclusive Transportation Pilot Program. Shortly after the pilots began, it was proposed to link all the pilot and future area services together through a 1-877 phone line and Website.

WHAT IS THE GOAL OF DIAL-A-RIDE NOVA SCOTIA?

The goal is to link all existing and future community-based inclusive transportation providers in Nova Scotia through a common theme logo, 1-800 phone services and Website. For instance, inter-regional connectivity through the networking of existing and future community services would create opportunities for clients to access community-based inclusive transportation when planning trips inter-regionally.

HOW DO I CONNECT TO THE DIAL-A-RIDE WEBSITE AND PHONE SERVICES?

Through Dial-a-Ride Nova Scotia, the three pilot areas were linked to each other through a theme logo, toll-free line at **1-877-305-RIDE (7344)** and through the Dial-a-Ride Website at www.gov.ns.ca/snsmr/dialaride.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF JOINING DIAL-A-RIDE NOVA SCOTIA?

This network would provide benefits to each participating local service by providing a forum for information exchange on common issues and sharing of resources.
