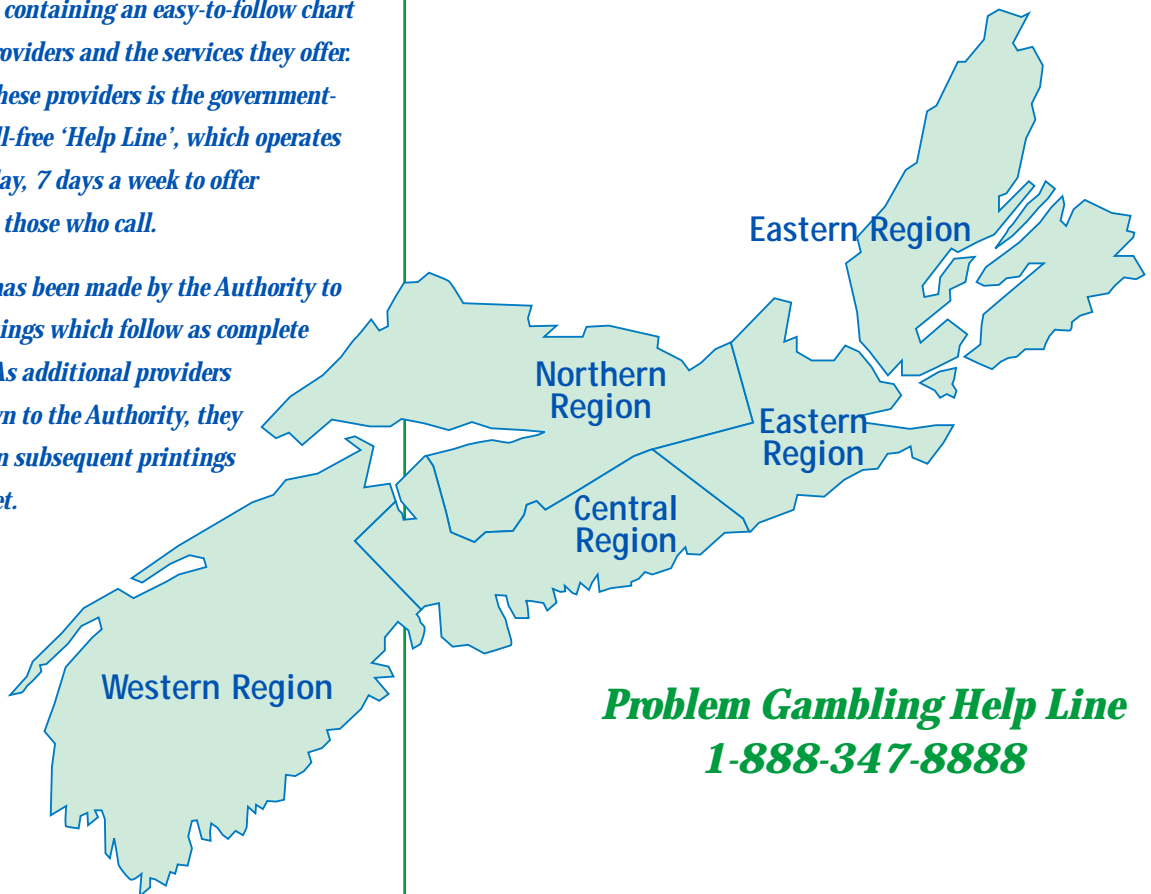
In its 1998 Annual Report, the Alcohol and Gaming Authority recommended a booklet be made available to the general public containing a listing of front-line service providers who can help people who feel they may have a gambling addiction problem.

This booklet divides the province into four regions, each containing an easy-to-follow chart listing the providers and the services they offer. Blanketing these providers is the government-sponsored toll-free 'Help Line', which operates 24 hours a day, 7 days a week to offer assistance to those who call.

Every effort has been made by the Authority to make the listings which follow as complete as possible. As additional providers become known to the Authority, they will appear in subsequent printings of this booklet.

Objective To provide support and information to people with gambling problems.

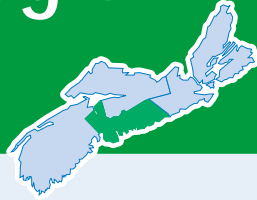
