NOTICE Re: Antigonish, Halifax, Hants and Victoria

Omission of Grantor Entries

A statutory declaration was submitted to four counties in September/ October 2004 to notify searchers of mineral rights owned by National Gypsum and USG Canadian Mining interest and which affects several parcels in the four counties . These rights may not have been mentioned in previous deeds or may be outside of the 40 year search range. Within a few weeks of registration, the Grantors were placed in the Property Online GGI (with the exception of instrument number 76352153), but not the GG Search in the registry vaults. The document was also linked to all affected PIDs, as supplied by National Gypsum and USG Canadian Mining, so the document information was in the parcel database for each affected parcel.
