Service Nova Scotia and Municipal Relations will once again deliver the Property Tax Rebate for Seniors Program on behalf of the Department of Community Services.

The Senior Property Tax Rebate Program provides a 50% rebate of your residential municipal property taxes, up to a maximum of \$400, providing you meet **all** of the following requirements.

- Received or were eligible to receive the Guaranteed Income Supplement or the Allowance in January 2009
- Still live in your home when you apply for the rebate
- Your 2008 Municipal Residential Property Taxes are in your name or include your name
- Your 2008 Municipal Residential Property Taxes are paid in full
- Your application is received postmarked no later than December 31, 2009

If you meet the above requirements, please complete an application form and return it to Property Tax Rebate for Seniors Program, Box 283, Halifax CRO, B3J 2N7 or to your nearest Access Nova Scotia centre. To locate an Access Nova Scotia centre, please call 1-800-670-4357 or in Metro at 424-5200. Please be sure to include copies of your 2008 Municipal Residential Tax Bill and receipt(s) **showing payment in full**. If you do not have this information you will need to obtain a statement from your municipal tax office.
