

# Highway 104 Twinning Project



### Earth moved:

Moved 5.6 million cubic metres of earth. That's enough dirt and rock to fill 2,240 Olympic-sized swimming pools.




# **Paving:**

Laid over 320,000 tonnes of asphalt. That's roughly the same as more than 150 football fields.



## **People employed:**

The project created more than 2 million hours of employment, or the same as hiring 300 people full-time for 40 months.



### **Environmental enhancements:**

Environmental enhancements include wildlife corridors, fencing and improved culverts that restore upstream fish passage.

Adult Atlantic salmon were seen in the new Middle Brook stream re-alignment in November 2021.



# Site safety:

More than 1,750 people completed safety orientations, and DNA Safety has received its 2022-23 Letter of Good Standing from Construction Safety Nova Scotia.
