

LaMPSS Introduction

Labour Market Programs Support System (LaMPSS) is a common system and set of business processes developed to focus on the administration of labour market programs. LaMPSS enables government and you, our service providers, to share information securely and efficiently in real time.

LaMPSS is a bi-lingual system that will provide you with the ability to:

- Complete funding applications online for specific programs
- Submit required activity and financial reports for funding agreements
- View your agreement contract
- View current and past funding agreements and pay history
- Update your organizations information in LaMPSS
- Manage the services delivered under your agreement(s) and register clients
- Access to your government agreement manager for information/support for your agreement(s)
- User/technical support from LaMPSS Operations Support

LaMPSS Government Partners
