

Release 3.4.2.1 Release Notes for External Users

LaMPSS Release 3.4.2.1 includes enhancements to align with the first implementation of the NS Works Online Digital Intake form. It also includes minor defect fixes to the Service Registration modules.

External Case Management (ECM)

Employment Nova Scotia is introducing a new "NS Works Digital Intake Form" on their NS Works Online web site. This form will replace the current paper form that was previously used by clients visiting NS Works service providers. Clients will be invited to complete this "online" form. NS Works staff will log into the NS Works Online web site to view the NS Works Digital Intake forms that have been submitted. They will then complete the intake on the External Case Management in LaMPSS. A subsequent release is planned to introduce an automated interface between NS Works Online and LaMPSS.

Enhancements to LaMPSS External Case Management (ECM) are required to align the new intake form as questions and answers have changed and support a process where some of the information will be obtained after the intake in a follow-up discussion with the client.

- Case Add Remove SIN as mandatory field when creating an ECM case (TFS 29486).
- ➤ Intake Details Align the questions / answers to the new NS Works Digital Intake form and to the questions / answers that will be obtained after the intake. Also remove rule that requires consent / intake form to be attached to the Intake Details (TFS 29344).
- Case Task Add new rule to make SIN required upon completion of "Complete Assessment" task.
- ➤ Application Package When an application for funding is submitted, some ECM intake information is automatically transferred to the newly created IFA agreement. Since some of the ECM intake questions / answers have changed, these changes also need to be applied to automated transfer process (TFS 29534).
- ➤ ECM Case Manager Statement / Action Plan Report Small changes to align with new terminology introduced by new NS Works Digital Intake Form (TFS 29534)
- Menu Remove link to previous ECM Intake form.

Service Registration

> Service Registration Participants

- Adjust rule for overlapping sessions For Individual services, the validation rule that verifies
 no overlapping sessions between participant records was modified to ignore session dates
 that overlap between the historical participants records. The rule should only compare the
 new session that is being added with all historical participant records for the same
 person. Also modified Session validation rules to ignore all deleted registrations (TFS
 29630).
- New validation to prevent overlapping For Individual services, a new validation was added when registering a person via Person Home Page to prevent overlapping session dates between participant records for the same person (TFS 29715).
